



## SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CONTRAST AND CONTAINMENT OF THE DIFFUSION OF THE COVID-19 VIRUS DURING THE STOP OVER GENOVA OF THE "GRAND PRIX D'ITALIE - MINI 6.5" REGATTA

In order to ensure a *Covid-free* place <u>during the Genoa stage of the "Grand Prix d'Italie - Mini 6.5" regatta</u> (10-16 April 2021) and in the days before (6-9 April 2021), Yacht Club Italiano implements its own protocols safety with the provisions of the national and local health authorities and the Italian Sailing Federation.

- It is mandatory for all participants to undergo an antigenic swab at the Scuola di Mare infirmary, or to submit a negative swab report performed privately within 48 hours before accessing the sports site of the Yacht Club Italiano.
- The nurse in charge of carrying out the tampons on behalf of the Yacht Club Italiano is present from April 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> 2021, from 4 pm to 6 pm. Participants who arrive early or, in any case, at different times, will have to wait in the areas outside the sports site of the Yacht Club Italiano.
- It is mandatory to have a duly completed self-certification provided by the Yacht Club Italiano, which must be delivered when accessing the sports site.
- Any form of gathering is prohibited.
- It is mandatory to respect the routes set up in order to avoid gatherings.
- It is mandatory to wear the mask correctly during all activities on land, including hauling and launching. During the regatta in the water and only for the athletes there is no obligation to wear a mask.
- It is mandatory to keep the interpersonal distance of at least 1 meter in all open and closed areas of the sports site.
- Frequent hand washing with alcohol-based solutions available at the sports site is strongly recommended.
- It is mandatory to undergo daily temperature measurements when accessing the sports site. Access is denied in case of temperatures above 37.5 ° C.
- Vehicle access is allowed subject to availability.
- The use of changing rooms is forbidden. Instead, the use of the toilets at the "Beppe Croce" Scuola di Mare is allowed.
- Registrations are made exclusively electronically on the Yacht Club Italiano website.
- Payment is made by bank transfer or other method that avoids any payment and contact when accessing the Club.
- Any other document must be sent to the Yacht Club Italiano by e-mail to regate@yci.it.
- The Office of the Mini Class, for carrying out the measurement checks, located at the "Beppe Croce" Scuola di Mare, works from April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- The Regatta Office, located on the first floor of the registered office, works from April 8<sup>th</sup> 2021 at 2.00 pm.
- Race communications and rankings are also published electronically through the Telegram channel called "GPI Mini650".

• Anyone presenting symptoms attributable to Covid-19 infection (body temperature above 37.5 ° C, cough, breathing difficulties) must notify their manager and Yacht Club Italiano, who proceeds according to the procedure better defined in the Generic Protocol containing measures to contrast and contain the diffusion of the "Covid 19" virus during the sailing competitions.
