**SPECIFIC INDICATIONS TO CONTRAST AND CONTAIN
THE DIFFUSION OF THE COVID-19 VIRUS
ON THE OCCASION OF THE SPRING REGATTAS, SPLENDIO MARE CUP, PORTOFINO**

In order to ensure a covid-free area during the "Spring Regattas - Portofino" (05-09 May 2021), Yacht Club Italiano implements its safety protocols with the provisions of the national and local Health Authorities and the Italian Federation Sailing.

- In order to access the site of the event, each participant must register and obtain the appropriate pass (printed or stored on their device) necessary for the purpose of tracking the subjects and which also determines the possibility of accessing between the different areas of the event. The passes will be delivered via email by the organization.
- All participants in the event are required to **undergo an antigenic swab at Molo Umberto I**. For subjects from foreign countries, it is also mandatory to comply with the provisions of the National Health Authority, which can be consulted in the section "Sports site of the competitions" of the *Generic Protocol containing measures to contrast and contain the diffusion of the "Covid 19" virus during the conduct of sail competitions* available on the Yacht Club Italiano website.
- **Those who are in possession of the "green certification" or who demonstrate that they have carried out a swab with a negative result in the 48 hours prior to the first entry to the sporting event are excluded from the previous point. Those who make use of this procedure, before**

their arrival, in order to make the pass valid, must send a copy of the certification or the negative result of the swab to the email address yci@wingsoft.it

- Swabs can be carried out from 5th May 2021, from 9 to 12 am and from 3 to 6 pm. Each participant, anyhow, in the event will have to repeat the swab after 72 hours have elapsed from the first access to the event site.
- During the access phase and after the swab or after the demonstration of negativity to the virus, the Organization of the event provides the distribution to the participants of a bracelet that allows entry into the different areas of the event site. This measure is taken in order to widen as much as possible the traceability of the flows of people and in order to guarantee the best safety standards and to contrast against Covid-19 contagion.
- It is mandatory that each member of the crews participating in the regattas must have to obtain self-certification available on the Yacht Club Italiano website (https://www.yachtclubitaliano.it/easyUp/file/285_allegato_3_autocert.pdf) duly completed and certifying the successful exhibition **daily temperature** by the athletes on board their boats, to be delivered daily to the Regatta Secretariat.
- Any form of gathering is prohibited.
- It is mandatory to respect the routes prepared in order to avoid gatherings, observing the indications provided by the signs placed on the site of the event.
- It is mandatory to wear the mask correctly during all activities on land, including hauling and launching. During the regatta - in the water - and only for the athletes there is no obligation to wear a mask.
- It is mandatory to maintain the interpersonal distance of at least 1 meter in all open and closed areas of the event site.
- Frequent hand washing with alcohol-based solutions available at the event site is strongly recommended.
- Documents and communications regarding the practices about the regattas must be sent to the Yacht Club Italiano by e-mail to regate@yci.it.
- The Regatta Secretariat, at Molo Umberto I, is operational from 5th May 2021, from 2.00 pm to 7.00 pm. Further information are available on the Yacht Club Italiano website. (<https://www.yachtclubitaliano.it/it/news-328/regate-di-primavera-splendido-mare-cup.html>).

- Anyone presenting symptoms attributable to Covid-19 infection (body temperature above 37.5 ° C, cough, breathing difficulties) must notify their manager and Yacht Club Italiano, who proceeds
